We celebrate two days dedicated to Mary in May: the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church on May 21 and the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary on May 31. But did you know that October is also a month dedicated to Mary? October features the Feast of the Holy Rosary on October 7 and by extension, the entire month is dedicated to the Rosary.
